Installing Acrobat Reader to read the course materials

The Course Guide, study units and other course materials are provided in PDF format, but to read them you need a PDF reader. Although many mobile devices nowadays have a built-in reader for PDF files, you are still suggested to download and install Acrobat Reader, a common PDF viewing app with useful features such as adding highlights and notes. You can download Acrobat Reader app from the following website:

Downloading your electronic course materials

The electronic materials for your course are available for downloading from the course's Online Learning Environment (OLE) as PDF files. After downloading the course materials to your mobile devices, you can then study either online or offline using your device.

To download course materials (e.g. study units), log on to your course on the OLE using a Web browser, and click on the link for your course.

Click on '**Study units**' and select a unit for downloading. A download icon should have appeared on the notification area of your device. 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Select '**Adobe Acrobat**' to open the study unit.

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Organizing your electronic course materials

To better organize your files, open a dedicated folder for files (Course Guide and Study Units) of a particular course. Since the user interface and operations for downloading vary for different devices, the instructions below simply give you a general idea how this can be done.

In general, Android devices store downloaded files in a 'Download' folder. This is located in '**My Files**' (or '**File Manager**'/'**Explorer**') which you can find inside the '**Apps**'.

When "**My Files**" is opened, click the "**Download**" folder to open it.

You should be able to find all the study units you downloaded before (e.g. bis_ b123_u01_150.pdf) in the Download folder. Click the '**Create folder**' icon inside the Download folder, and name the new folder (for example BIS B123) so that all files of the course can be put in this folder. Click '**Done**' when you have finished naming your folder. 你可在下載資料夾找到曾下載的 所有修讀單元(例如bis_b123_ u01_150.pdf)。在下載資料夾內點 擊"建立資料夾"圖示,並為新資 料夾命名(例如BIS B123),之後便 可把學科的所有檔案儲存於此。命 名後點擊"完成"按鈕。

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To move the downloaded course materials into the course folder, select the PDF file(s) by clicking the checkbox next to the file name. Then click the '**Move**' icon, and all the files will be removed from the present location. 要將已下載的檔案移至學科資料 夾,按下檔案名稱旁的選框選取 PDF檔案,然後點擊右上方"**移** 動"圖示,所選檔案會從當前位置 移除。

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Then go into the course folder (for example BIS B123) by clicking on it. Now click the '**Paste**' icon, so that the selected files will now be placed into this folder. 點選所需資料夾(例如 BIS B123), 然後點擊"**貼上**"圖示,之前所選 檔案就會移至這一資料夾。

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In this way, you store all course materials in a folder according to their course code. 這樣,你就可按學科編號儲存教材 於資料夾內。

Studying your electronic course materials

If you use a mobile device, it is not advisable that you access your course materials through the OLE. You should just open the study unit using Acrobat Reader.

To start reading a study unit, go to Download folder and then the course folder you created earlier. Click on the course material PDF file to open it.

In some cases, you may be required to select an app to open the PDF file. Select '**Adobe Acrobat**' and click '**Always**'. 有時,你或需揀選應用程式開啟 PDF檔案。選取"Adobe Acrobat" 並點選"總是"。

	Moore's law	
	As you can see, from the first generation to now, the size and cost of computers have continually decreased, while their capabilities and reliability continue to increase. Today computers are indispensable tools in most people's lives, which is amazing if you consider that the entire history of computers began only about 70 years ago. The development of computers has therefore been very fast, compared with other scientific and technological developments and inventions (e.g. people began to study physics and chemistry several centuries ago.)	
	To describe such a long-term and ongoing trend in the increasing complexity of computer hardware, one of the founders of Intel, Gordon E Moore (1965), introduced the concept that the complexity of integrated circuits (measured in number of transistors) doubles about every two years under the same cost, based on his experience and observation. As the speed of computers is directly proportional to the number of their transistors, this also means the computing power that each dollar can buy doubles about every two years. This is now commonly known as Moore's law.
