Admission Requirements

- Local applicants: Registered Nurse with valid professional and practicing certificates issued by Nursing Council of Hong Kong; or
- ♦ Non-local applicants: Nurse with recognized professional and practicing qualification issued by the relevant professional body outside Hong Kong; and
- → Holding a recognized Bachelor's degree in Nursing or health-related discipline; and
- → Fulfil the University's English language proficiency requirements.

Career Prospect/Professional Recognition*

- Graduates who satisfactorily completed all programme requirements will be awarded a Master's degree in Nursing.
- Graduates with cumulative clinical experience may subsequently experience career development as advanced practice nurse, nurse manager or leader in healthcare setting.

*Completion of this programme would not lead to eligibility of registering as Registered Nurse (RN) with the Nursing Council of Hong Kong.
