

Programme Requirements for Bachelor of General Studies and Associate of General Studies

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of General Studies (BGST)

- 1.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of General Studies (BGST), a student shall:
- 1.1.1 obtain at least 90 credit-units as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level, and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:
 - 1.1.1.1 at least 75 credit-units from any undergraduate courses offered by the University at 1000-level or above, of which no more than 21 credit-units shall be at 1000-level, and at least 21 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level;
 - 1.1.1.2 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
 - 1.1.1.3 6 credit-units of University English courses labelled UEC in Table 1;
- and
- 1.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

Early Exit option for students admitted to BGST

Students admitted to the BGST programme may opt to exit with the award Associate of General Studies (AGST). The programme requirement for the award of AGST is listed in paragraph 2.

2. Programme Requirement – Associate of General Studies (AGST)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of Associate of General Studies (AGST), a student shall:
- 2.1.1 obtain at least 60 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 30 credit-units shall be at 2000-/3000-level:
 - 2.1.1.1 at least 54 credit-units from any undergraduate courses offered by the University at 1000-level or above, of which at least 27 credit-units shall be at 2000-/3000-level;
 - 2.1.1.2 6 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
- and
- 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of sub-degrees.
