

# Programme Requirements for Master of Nursing and Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing/ Extensive End-of-life Care/ Management and Leadership/ Chinese Medicinal Nursing)

This set of programme requirements is applicable to students admitted in 2025 Autumn term and thereafter.

#### 1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

1.1. A student shall complete the **Master of Nursing or Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

<sup>\*</sup>The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.

- 1.2. To enter the **Master of Nursing or Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing** programme, a student should:
  - 1.2.1 be a Registered Nurse with valid professional and practicing certificates issued by Nursing Council of Hong Kong (for Hong Kong applicants);

or

be a nurse with recognized professional and practicing qualification issued by the relevant professional body outside Hong Kong (for non-local applicants); and

- 1.2.2 have a recognized Bachelor's degree in Nursing or health-related discipline; and
- 1.2.3 satisfy the University's English language proficiency requirements.
- 1.3. To enter the **Master of Nursing or Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing** programme through pathway 1 (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing/ Extensive End-of-Life Care), a student should:
  - 1.3.1 be a Registered Nurse with valid professional and practicing certificates issued by Nursing Council of Hong Kong (for Hong Kong applicants);

or

- be a nurse with recognized professional and practicing qualification issued by the relevant professional body outside Hong Kong (for non-local applicants); and
- 1.3.2 have a recognized Bachelor's degree in Nursing or health-related discipline; and
- 1.3.3 possess a Post-registration Certificate Course qualification in Respiratory Nursing (for specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing) or Palliative Care Nursing (for specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care), awarded by the Institute of Advanced Nursing Studies, Hospital Authority, and
- 1.3.4 satisfy the University's English language proficiency requirements.



#### 2. Articulation of Qualifications

- 2.1. The Regulations Governing the Articulation of Qualifications shall apply for conversion of the Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing to the award of Master of Nursing.
- 3. Programme Requirement Master of Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing) (MNARNF)
  - 3.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing shall:
    - 3.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 3.1.1.1 9 credit-units from all common core courses labelled CC and CD in Table 1;
      - 3.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Advanced Respiratory Nursing, labelled RN1 and RN2 in Table 1;
      - 3.1.1.3 6 credit-units from the Capstone project labelled CAP in Table 1;

and

- 3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
- 4. Programme Requirement Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing) (PDNARNF)
  - 4.1. To be eligible for the award of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing shall:
    - 4.1.1 obtain 18 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 4.1.1.1 3 credit-units from the common core course NURS 8622NEF in Table 1;
      - 4.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Advanced Respiratory Nursing, labelled RN1 and RN2 in Table 1;

and



- 5. Programme Requirement Master of Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing) through pathway 1 (MNARNF1)
  - 5.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing through pathway 1 shall:
    - 5.1.1 obtain 24 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 5.1.1.1 9 credit-units from all common core courses labelled CC and CD in Table 1;
      - 5.1.1.2 9 credit-units from all specialization courses in Advanced Respiratory Nursing, labelled RN1 in Table 1;
      - 5.1.1.3 6 credit-units from the Capstone project labelled CAP in Table 1;

and

- 5.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
- 6. Programme Requirement Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing) through pathway 1 (PDARNF1)
  - 6.1. To be eligible for the award of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing through pathway 1 shall:
    - 6.1.1 obtain 12 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 6.1.1.1 3 credit-units from the common core course NURS 8622NEF in Table 1;
      - 6.1.1.2 9 credit-units from all specialization courses in Advanced Respiratory Nursing, labelled RN1 in Table 1;

## 7. Programme Requirement – Master of Nursing (with specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care) (MNEELCF)

- 7.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care shall:
  - 7.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:
    - 7.1.1.1 9 credit-units from all common core courses labelled CC and CD in Table 1;
    - 7.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Extensive End-of-Life Care, labelled EE1 and EE2 in Table 1;
    - 7.1.1.3 6 credit-units from the Clinical practicum labelled CLP in Table 1;

and

- 7.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
- 8. Programme Requirement Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Extensive Endof-Life Care) (PDNEELCF)
  - 8.1. To be eligible for the award of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care shall:
    - 8.1.1 obtain 18 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 8.1.1.1 3 credit-units from the common core course NURS 8622NEF in Table 1;
      - 8.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Extensive End-of-Life Care, labelled EE1 and EE2 in Table 1;

and



- 9. Programme Requirement Master of Nursing (with specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care) through pathway 1 (MNEELCF1)
  - 9.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care through pathway 1 shall:
    - 9.1.1 obtain 24 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 9.1.1.1 9 credit-units from all common core courses labelled CC and CD in Table 1;
      - 9.1.1.2 9 credit-units from all specialization courses in Extensive End-of-Life Care, labelled EE2 in Table 1;
      - 9.1.1.3 6 credit-units from the Clinical practicum labelled CLP in Table 1;

and

- 9.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
- 10. Programme Requirement Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Extensive Endof-Life Care) through pathway 1 (PDNEELCF1)
  - 10.1. To be eligible for the award of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Extensive End-of-Life Care through pathway 1 shall:
    - 10.1.1 obtain 12 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 10.1.1.1 3 credit-units from the common core course NURS 8622NEF in Table 1;
      - 10.1.1.2 9 credit-units from all specialization courses in Extensive End-of-Life Care, labelled EE2 in Table 1;

## 11. Programme Requirement – Master of Nursing (with specialization in Management and Leadership) (MNMLF)

- 11.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Management and Leadership shall:
  - 11.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:
    - 11.1.1.1 9 credit-units from all common core courses labelled CC and CD in Table 1;
    - 11.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Management and Leadership, labelled ML in Table 1;
    - 11.1.1.3 6 credit-units from the Capstone project labelled CAP in Table 1;

and

- 11.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
- 12. Programme Requirement Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Management and Leadership) (PDNMLF)
  - 12.1. To be eligible for the award of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Management and Leadership shall:
    - 12.1.1 obtain 18 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 12.1.1.1 3 credit-units from the common core course NURS 8622NEF in Table 1;
      - 12.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Management and Leadership, labelled ML in Table 1;

## 13. Programme Requirement – Master of Nursing (with specialization in Chinese Medicinal Nursing) (MNCMNF)

- 13.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Chinese Medicinal Nursing shall:
  - 13.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:
    - 13.1.1.1 6 credit-units from the common core courses labelled CC in Table;
    - 13.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Chinese Medicinal Nursing, labelled CM in Table 1;
    - 13.1.1.3 3 credit-units from the Practicum course labelled CLPC in Table 1;
    - 13.1.1.4 6 credit-units from the Capstone project labelled CAPC in Table 1;

and

- 13.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
- 14. Programme Requirement Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing (with specialization in Chinese Medicinal Nursing) (PDNMNF)
  - 14.1. To be eligible for the award of the **Postgraduate Diploma in Nursing**, a student pursuing the specialization in Chinese Medicinal Nursing shall:
    - 14.1.1 obtain 18 credit-units as prescribed below:
      - 14.1.1.1 15 credit-units from all specialization courses in Chinese Medicinal Nursing, labelled CM in Table 1;
      - 14.1.1.2 3 credit-units from the Practicum course labelled CLPC in Table 1;
