About the Speaker

Angel M. Y. Lin is Professor and Tier 1 Canada Research Chair in Plurilingual and Intercultural Education at Simon Fraser University, Canada. She has published widely on second language education, discourse analysis, trans/languageing (TL), trans-semiotizing (TS), Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL), and academic literacies.

Abstract

Disciplinary literacy refers to the ability to appropriately participate in the communicative practices of a discipline (Airey 2016). Researching disciplinary literacy becomes especially important in Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) as the CLIL teacher needs to help students to develop the onto-epistemological orientations and literacy practices specific to the discipline, while doing these in the additional language of the students. In this seminar, I propose an Integrative Model for systematically conceptualizing DL in CLIL by integrating insights from research on pedagogical applications of Thematic Patterns (Lemke, 1990; He & Lin, 2019; Wu & Lin, 2022).
